Route 143

Route 143 in the Municipality of Hatley runs parallel to Lake Massawippi, offering vistas on Mt. Orford, certainly, but also on the Bunker Hills. The views along this road are possible thanks to active farming, such as the Bouffard's cattle farm, whose products may be found at the Face de Bœuf butcher shop in Ayer's Cliff, and Domaine Bergeville, offering exceptional organic sparkling wines.

Eustis Covered Bridge

Covered bridge between Waterville and Canton de Hatley. Built in 1908, this 27-meter-long bridge is open to traffic from April 15 to November 15, offering a view on Mt. Hatley, formerly known as Mt. Joie. It is one of the five stopovers proposed in the real escape game *Légendes du lac Massawippi*

Chemin de la Montagne

The *chemin de la Montagne* in Sainte-Catherine-de-Hatley is prized by both cycling and scenery enthusiasts, offering seven kilometres of panoramic views on the region's emblematic mountains - Mts. Orford and Owl's Head – and over the Lake Magog valley. The view is made possible by active farming in this part of the territory. Indeed, one may see the only remaining dairy farm in the Municipality, located on a parallel road, the *chemin d'Ayer's Cliff*.
