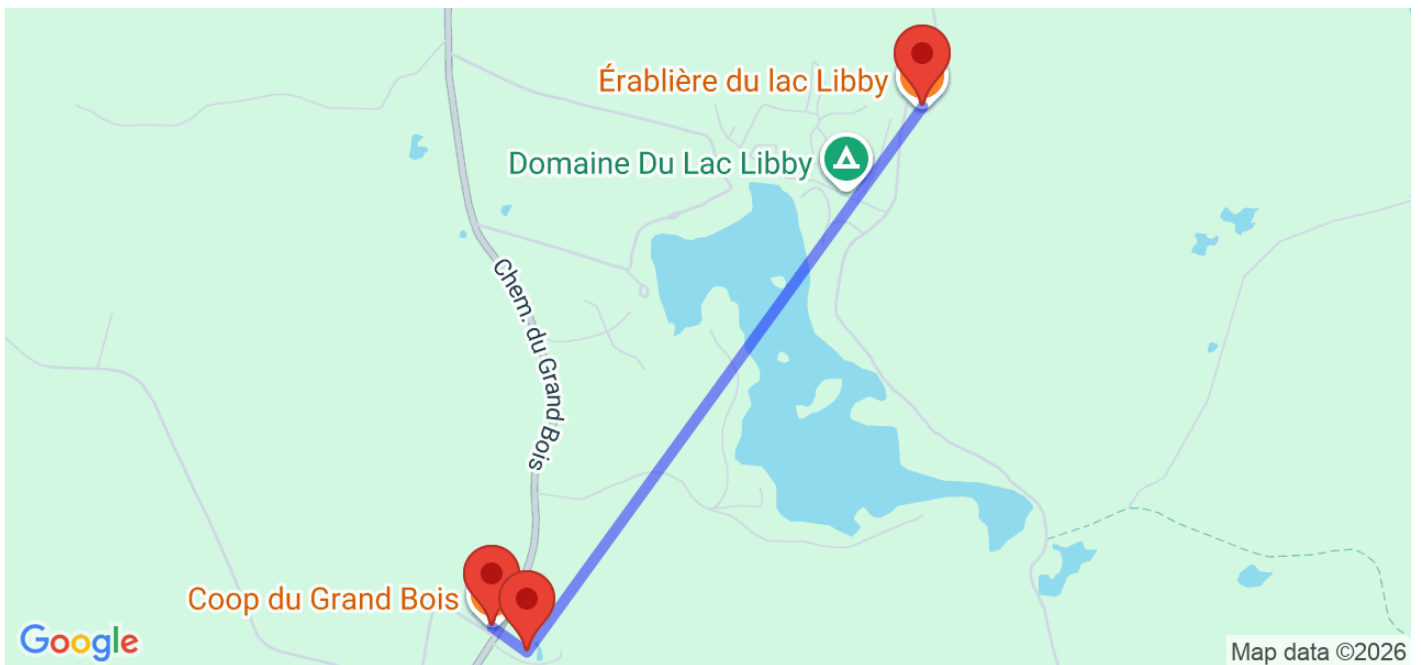


Culinary by car
